Drug addiction is a chronic condition that can affect many aspects of our life, including your physical and mental health. It includes using legal substances, such Cocaine, Heroin, Inhalants, Marijuana, taking a medicine prescribed for someone else or taking larger doses. etc. It can hurt people around you, including friends, families, kids and unborn babies.
