Copyright

- * Copyright gives creators legal **protection** for the things they create
- * Copyright law protects **printed** and **digital** content.
- * The **symbol** for copyright is © (letter C with a circle around it)
- * Copyright for a website is usually at the **bottom** of home page.
- * Copyright protects creators' work:



Books Images Music Movies Games Computer software Websites

▶ **Example:**

- 1- Downloading a TV episode on YouTube
- 2- Using someone else's artwork on your social media account

▶ **When you use copyrighted content:**

- ① Respect the creator's work and use it fairly.
- ② Ask for permission to use it.

Creative works are not covered by copyright

1- Identify **reliable** digital sources such as **EKB**.

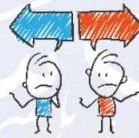
2- Go to the site you want by typing **URL** in the search engine

URL is the abbreviation for "Uniform Resource Locator."

3- Store recommended websites on a Bookmark bar for easy access.

4- You must differ between facts and pinions

► To make research paper

- Take notes for each source
(add the **URL** and the **author's name** at the **top** of your notes)
- Use quotation marks to add exact author's important words
- Do paraphrasing (use your words to explain the idea of the writer)

- Cite the sources

- List your sources on a "**Works Cited**" page at the **end** of research report
Some online sources include a permalink to use as the cited web address
From "**share**" or "**cite this**" take the permalink
(permalink is permanent **hyperlink**, **word** or **picture** take you to web location)

► How to cite a source

Put the citations in alphabetical order by:

- 1- Write author's last name.
- 2- If the source doesn't have an author write title of the article
- 3- Write the source: the name of the book, journal, or website.
- 4-Write the date: the year the source was published.
- 5- Mention the URL



► Citing a YouTube Video

- 1- Write author (creator) of the video.
- 2- Write the date the video was uploaded.
- 3- Write the video title followed by the word "video".
- 4- Write the name of the site (YouTube) and the URL of the video
